Recruitment Rule for the post of Hostel  
Superintendent-cum-Physical Training Instructor at  
the Industrial Training Institutes/Centres under the  
Craftsman Training Scheme.

Appointment to the post shall be made by nomination  
from amongst candidates who-

- i) are not less than 23 years of age and unless  
already in the service of the Government of  
Maharashtra are not more than 35 years of age;
- ii) hold Secondary School Certificate issued by the  
S.S.C. Examination Board or its equivalent;
- iii) hold certificate in Physical education of a  
recognised Institute;
- iv) possess minimum experience of one year of  
organisation of work and administrative ability;
- v) possess ability to keep and maintain proper  
account of expenditure;
- vi) possess ability to supervise games and sports  
and other recreational facilities.

Preference may be given to the candidates who  
possess experience for not less than 3 years in supervising  
games and sports and other recreational facilities.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed  
in favour of candidates possessing good qualifications  
and/or experience.

The selected candidate shall be required to pass  
an examination in Hindi according to the prescribed  
rules, unless he has already done so.
